Reconstruction Commission, in collaboration with Pinchina Consulting, kicks off National Palace Architectural Design Competition

Calling interested consultants and firms to be involved in the design of the new Haitian National Palace

New York, NY: Pinchina Consulting LLC, a Haitian-American-led urban planning and public policy firm, serving as liaison between the Presidential Commission for the Reconstruction of the Haitian National Palace and Haitian Civil Society abroad, released the Expression of Interest (EOI) to kick off the Haitian National Palace Reconstruction Design Competition.

After the National Palace was severely damaged in the earthquake of 2010, the Haitian Government formed the Presidential Commission for the Reconstruction of the Haitian National Palace in April 2017 to ensure that the sons and daughters of Haiti, across all generations, unite in rebuilding both the National Palace and the nation's post-earthquake identity.

Speaking at the temporary presidential residence on the grounds of the collapsed palace, President Jovenel Moïse called for the committee of engineers and architects to oversee the project, noting that "for many, the post-earthquake reconstruction has not begun as long as the National Palace has not been rebuilt."
